Ladies & Gentlemen,

Please be aware of the NSFMHL rules & policies for 2009-2010.

GAME PROTOCOL

Time Frame

10-minutes prior to scheduled game time
Scheduled game time
2-Minutes left in warm-up
1-Minute left in warm-up
10-minutes after scheduled game time

Event

Ice will be resurfaced
Teams will warm-up for 10-minutes
Officials on-ice for game
Team pick-up the pucks
National anthem & start of period one

Teams will play 2 x 15-minute stop time periods. Following the second period the ice shall be resurfaced. Teams will return to the ice as soon as it is ready (as there is no set intermission length) to commence a 20-minute stop time period. Officials are expected to be on the ice prior to the teams.

Following the third period teams will shake hands and stand on their blue line for the player of the game presentation.

RULES

- Each team shall be permitted to take one thirty (30) second time out.
- Player in uniform – please refer to Hockey Canada rule 2.2.
- HNSMC regulations do NOT apply to this league.
- There is NO overtime or shoot-outs during regular season play.

INCIDENT REPORTS

All incident reports MUST be submitted electronically to Ken Boyce at suspensions@hockeynovascotia.ca no later than 12:00pm the following day.

GAME FEES

- On-Ice officials will be paid in cash by the home team. Referee - \$50.00, Linesmen - \$25.00.
- Officials traveling (Halifax to Lantz, New Glasgow to Antigonish or Antigonish to Port Hawkesbury) to work games will be expected to go together. The driver will be compensated \$30.00 for travel expenses to be paid in cash prior to the game.
