

How to register for an Intro/Community Coach

1. Log on to your ehockey account (If you do not have an ehockey account set up please copy and paste this link into your web browser
http://www.hockeynovascotia.ca/user/File/4_%20EHOCKEY.pdf).
2. Click on HU – Community Coach
3. Click on Checkout (at this point you will be asked to select which level you are coaching. Please make sure you choose a level. DO NOT choose N/A).
4. From here you will be provided with a link that takes you directly to the site to begin the course.
5. Complete the course. It is set up to be 4 hours long, however Respect Group is able to set up these courses so that you are not obligated to compete it all at once. You can log into and out of the course at your leisure, however please remember that you will not be able to register for the classroom portion of this course until the online portion is complete.
6. Once the course has been completed in full, return to your ehockey account and click on the date for Intro/Community Coach course which best suits your schedule (There are approximately 25 in-person clinics. As they fill up they are removed from the list that is able to be seen online).
7. Proceed to checkout. At this point your name will be emailed to the clinic instructor who will be taking attendance at the classroom portion.

Please note that if you have registered for the classroom portion and fail to attend you will not be given credit for this course and will be unable to be on the bench.

***** Please note that individual coaches will not pay themselves when registering. Hockey Nova Scotia will be able to print a total invoice for each Minor Hockey Association at the completion of clinics season. It is important that it is communicated to your respective coaches what courses they need, and you keep your own audit internally so you have an estimate of clinics costs.**
