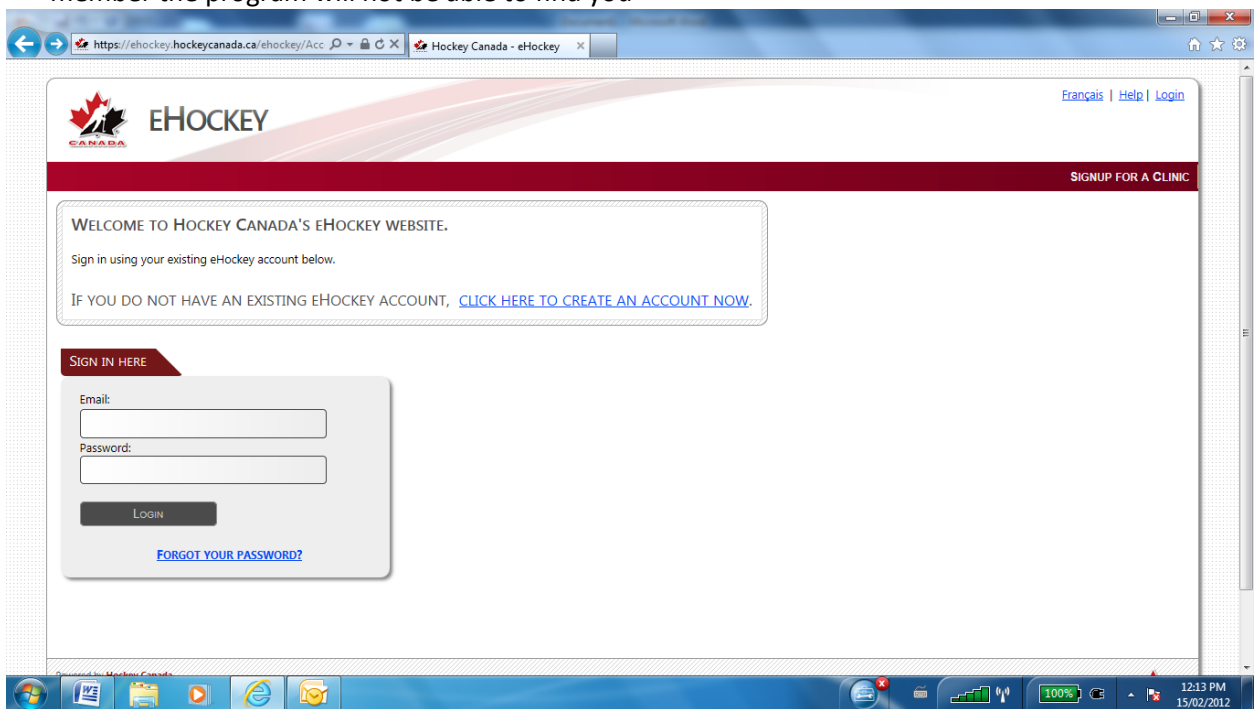


E-HOCKEY

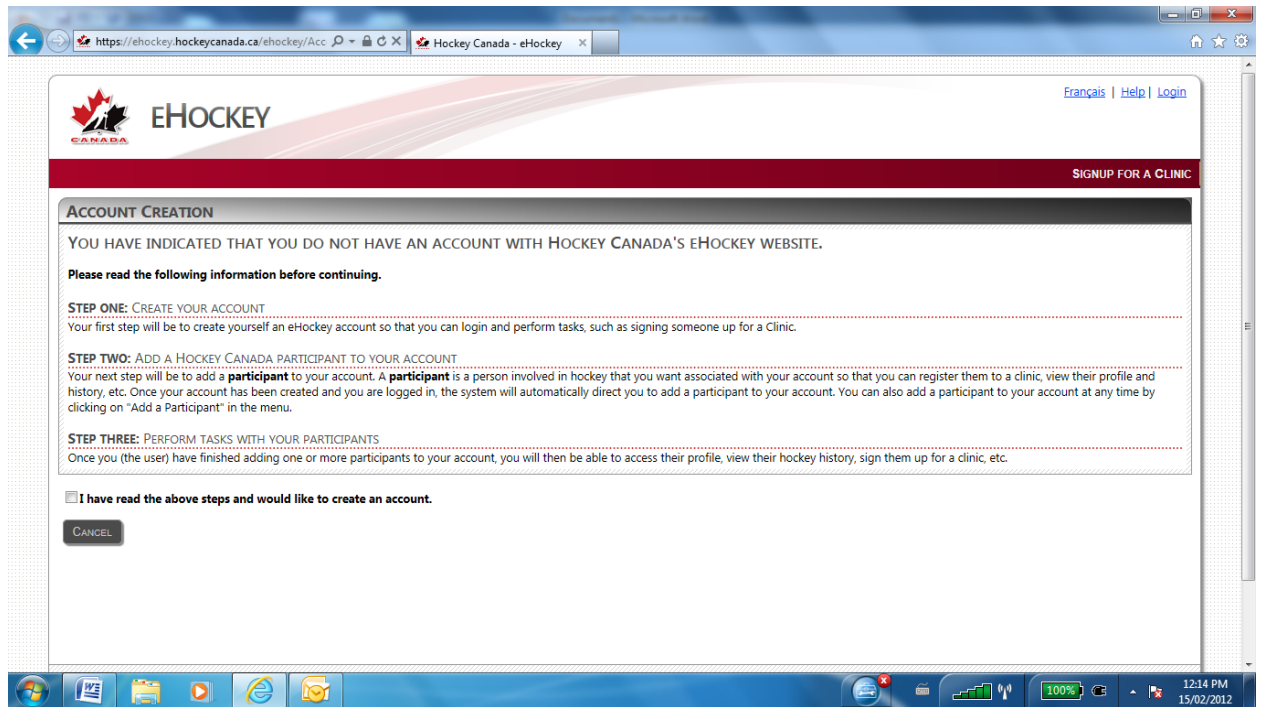
- Every coach, manager and volunteer who is contact with a team needs to have an EHOCKEY account.
- This is the website <https://ehockey.hockeycanada.ca>
- It is a great idea for each individual person to make sure all of their credentials are up to date. Although this is checked by the person responsible for qualifications within your minor hockey association and then double checked by the HNS Certification Coordinator, a lot of frustration can be saved by ensuring your own ehockey account is up to date.

REGISTRATION FOR E-HOCKEY

- This registration process can be a bit confusing; especially if you do not have a Hockey Canada Profile previously set up.
- If you do not have a profile set up on the Hockey Canada Registry, you can create one on your own by going to <https://ehockey.hockeycanada.ca>
- During this process you will be prompted to register as a new user but because you are not a member the program will not be able to find you



- Once you see this screen and click on "click here to create an account now" you will see



- Following this step you will be asked to input your information (address, phone number, date of birth etc.)
 - Once this information has been completed, you still will have to ADD YOURSELF to the clinic.
 - You will be asked “would you like to add someone to this account”.
 - **Essentially what this is asking is for you to add yourself to the account. So when prompted by this question, respond with YES.**
 - Once you have added yourself to the account, you can then add others if necessary.
