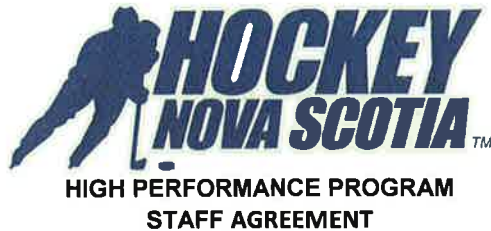

As a coach in the High Performance Program you are asked to respect and obey the following:

- provide a fair and impartial assessment of the participating athletes' at all times
- be consistent in evaluating each athlete applying the same expectations for all
- be consistent in evaluating athletes throughout the entire camp from game to game
- not allow others to interrupt my evaluations at any time or to distract me from my evaluation task
- maintain the utmost confidentiality of athlete evaluations and assessments at all times
- conduct myself appropriately at all times during the camp so as to avoid any perception of bias
- respect the opinions of other evaluators and ensure the integrity of the process at all times
- not use my role as an evaluator to gain personal advantage at any time for any reason
- to not use your position as an evaluator or coach to gain influence over players outside of the high performance program –recruiting players for your own club team or program

As a coach in the Hockey Nova Scotia High Performance Program, you are now part of the Hockey Nova Scotia, and as such your actions outside of the High Performance Program reflect directly on Hockey Nova Scotia and our many volunteers.

By signing this agreement, you agree to keep all information regarding the High Performance Program confidential. This includes, but is not limited to player evaluations, player rankings, player contact information, and player injuries.

You also understand, your conduct regarding both hockey and non-hockey related issues within Hockey Nova Scotia jurisdiction must be of a professional nature that is respectful and mindful of Hockey Nova Scotia protocol and procedure.
